Caliente Season Stats (after 6 games)

The Arizona Caliente has proven that they have one of the most balanced offensive attacks in all of women's football. Being able to move the ball on the run, as well as make the big pass plays, has those that face the Caliente constantly guessing. A major credit to the Caliente's offense is their Offensive Line, which is led by Center #70 Becky Gamble and has become a true force with such dominating linemen like #79 Hiroko "Betty" Suzuki and #61 Amy "A-Bomb" Arnold. The Caliente defense, which proved to be one of the best in the country during their 2001-2002 season, is continuing their reign keeping their opponents down to an average of less than 12 points per game (70 point for 6 games) and have had 2 shut out games already this season. Both returning defensive players from last seasons All-Star team such as (OL) #92 Kim Hoke on the line, as well emerging top talent like (LB) #9 Tina "Tink" Murphree have made the Caliente defense a well oiled machine.
