The Arizona Caliente (5-1) will host the LA Amazons (2-4) on Saturday, **September 20th at North High School (1101 E. Thomas Rd.) in Phoenix.** The Caliente opened their season on the road against the Amazons on August 9th, 2003 in CA, where the Caliente overpowered the Amazons in a 45-0 victory. The Amazons' wins have come against the So Cal Scorpions and Arizona Knighthawks, while the sole loss for the Caliente was against the Long Beach Aftershock. The Arizona Caliente (5-1) fell just yards short as time expired, and broke their undefeated record, against the Long Beach Aftershock (6-0). On any given game day, there must be a winning team and a losing team, but when asked about the game, Caliente Head Coach Gerry Turley commented "Yes, they (Long Beach) are a strong team, but we definitely had our missed opportunities and made some mistakes that we won't make next time against them." The Aftershock's game winning score came as they recovered a fumbled Caliente ball in their end zone for 6 points with :08 left in the 3rd quarter.
